The 2016, Central Wisconsin TU Workday stream restoration projects experienced another successful season thanks to the hard work and financial contributions from those persons dedicated to conserving, protecting and restoring Wisconsin's coldwater fisheries, e.g., CWTU, Fox Valley TU, Elliott Donnelly TU, Aldo Leopold TU, and WisDNR.

A description of each Workday is detailed later in this report. The 2016 highlights were:

- In 2016, the CWTU Workday coordinator duties were handed off from Scott Bahn to Dennis Drazkowski. A special thank you to Scott B. for his past efforts.
- Restoration projects on the White River, West Branch of the White River, Chaffee Creek and the Pine River.
- Total of 695 work and travel hours performed. Per the US Department of Labor Statistics this converts to a volunteer value of \$15,623.60 (\$22.48 per hour).
- Average of 25 persons per workday.
- Total workday expenditures, i.e., food, porta-potty and supplies, \$903.11.
- A special drawing will be held at the CWTU banquet eligible only to those persons who attended the summer workdays. The prize will be a CWTU embroidered "Stream Restoration" long-sleeve fishing shirt.
- Perfect workday attendance: Mike Maier, Tom Meyer, Mike Niemczyk and Rodger Suprise.
- Generous donation in May to CWTU by the Elliott Donnelly TU Chapter in the amount of \$3,700 for future stream restoration projects.
- Professional-quality workday photos taken by Nathan Ratliff of the Fox Valley TU Chapter.
- Implemented a "CWTU Volunteer Workday Liability and Visual Image Waiver" and "CWTU Parental Consent Form". Recommended by the National and State TU councils.
- Porta Potty on-site for 3 of the 5 workdays; rented from Packerland Portables in Wautoma.
- The CWTU and Elliott Donnelley TU chapters were successful in securing matching grants totaling \$9,000 from the Trout and Salmon Foundation for restoration activities on the Pine River for the 2016-2018 work seasons.

Planned Workday Activities for 2017:

Exact locations will be determined by the WDNR Fisheries unit in spring 2017. However, in 2016, a new 3 year project began on the Pine River east of Aniwa Rd (September workday). This will include work on both sides of 3,800 feet of stream. The Central Wisconsin and Elliott Donnelly TU Chapters have obtained and both chapters have matched a Trout and Salmon Foundation grant to cover the costs of bank material for this project. Total grant amount is \$9,000.00.
