Committee Notes:

- Work Project Conversation regarding signs w/ new logo and better posts (work project / trailer budget?).
- Work Project Conversation regarding chain sharpening (trailer budget ?).
- Membership Currently at 339 members (23 new / 2 renews).
- Education Sent 2 kids to State TU camp / Take-a-Kid-Fishing Day (~333 kids registered) / Kids Fishing Day (31 kids).
- Technology Continuing to post fresh content on website and social media. Switching to new website platform may have to wait until next year.
- Banquet 2023 47th Annual Conservation Banquet was a success. 2024 banquet tentatively scheduled for Feb 15th. First banquet committee meeting should be held next in October.
- VSP Continues to meet regularly.
- Legislative SB312 PFAS is still being considered in the legislature. The bill would dedicate \$125 million in the state budget toward PFAS remediation in WI. There is a portion of the bill that would place limitations on the DNR to test for PFAS at a suspected contamination site and compel remediation from companies responsible.
- Programs None booked for 2023-24 so far. Some suggestions included Priority Waters updates from either TU National's Chris Collier and/or Danielle Nelson.
- Alternative Fundraising Committee Beer of the Month Fundraiser with Titletown Brewery raised \$50 in beer sales. Oconto TU received the funds (given the small amount).
- Trout Trail Committee Final wave of Trout Trail signs have been designed by Randy and sent to Quick Signs for production. Goal is to have a workday in October to put them in the ground.
- Br Co Conservation Alliance Will start meeting again soon.
