- Haller Creek Brown Trout Stocking:
 - o According to WI DNR Fish Biologist, Jason Breeggemann (Green Bay):
 - Quota in for 325 yearling brown trout stocked in Haller Creek this spring.
 - If there are no significant die-offs or production issues, those fish will be stocked.
 - Typically, those yearlings are stocked the week before fishing opens. Sometimes, the yearlings get stocked 2 weeks before the opener depending on the number of fish to get stocked and the available stocking trucks.
 - All the trout are stocked between the NEW zoo and Sunrise Road, which is the section with the trout trail.
 - Stockings for 2026 and 2027 are still in the air with budgets.
